



Toolkit 4 - Worksheet 4b – Is God True – What Do You Think?

Choose one of the four thinkers. Read the information and answer these questions.

- Has this person done an experiment, which proves that God does not exist? Why/why not?
- Has this person investigated something in the world and said: 'We can explain this without believing that God did it'?
- Has this person said 'Humans think there is a God, but it's really just our imaginations'?
- Do you think this person has made a good argument that God does not exist? Why/why not?

What do you think?

Here are four ways of thinking about whether God is true:

Believer - I believe it is true that God exists, even though I can't do an experiment to prove it.

Agnostic 1 - We can't ever know whether God exists, because we can't do an experiment to prove it, with evidence but it is possible that there is a God.

Agnostic 2 - We can't ever know whether God exists, because we can't do an experiment to prove it with evidence, but it is very unlikely that there is a God.

Atheist - There is no evidence that God does exist. Therefore there is no God.
